The abstract should be a maximum of 500 words without title, authors name(s) and affiliation(s).

Oral presentations will be restricted to 20 minutes and 5 minutes of questions and transition. Presentations should be prepared in a Power Point format.

The maximum space available for each poster will be 120 x 80 cm. Posters will be displayed throughout the Symposium.
